- All kids will be required to read and follow "Camp Code of Conduct"
- We have NO tolerance for any Bullying behavior!
- Sailing and Windsurfing are sports that require WIND, on the days when there is NO wind we will proceed with other camp activities such as team games, kayak adventures and more!

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## IMPORTANT ON SAFETY FOR THE CAMPERS

### The law in Florida is that Kids have US Coast Guard Approved Life Jackets

All campers are required to bring their own Life Jacket  
Please make sure you buy the proper size.  
Inside all Lifejacket there is a weight/size.  
Measure to make sure you buy what  
your child needs (should fit snug)

*WE DO NOT PROVIDE LIFEJACKETS  
IF CAMPERS DO NOT HAVE PROPER LIFEJACKET  
THEY WILL NOT GO ON THE WATER*

### **Summer Camp Safety Protocol**

We take all safety measures very seriously and for that reason,  
we are reducing our camper spots again this summer.

**We offering 8 weeks of Camp - Time 9:00 am – 4:00pm**

**FEE: MYC Member \$360 / Non MYC Member \$410**

**After hours 4:00pm-5:30pm \$60 p/week**

*NO REFUNDS ON REGISTRATIONS*

Week 1: June 13th - June 17th

Week 3: June 27th - July 1st

Week 5: July 11th - July 15th

Week 7: July 25th - July 29th

Week 2: June 20th - June 24th

Week 4: July 4th - July 8th *YES! We have Camp on July 4th*

Week 6: July 18th - July 22th

Week 8: Aug 1st - Aug 5th

*(Small 8-10 camper teams that will stay the same group throughout the week with same instructors and counselors)*

#### **VERY IMPORTANT**

**PARENTS: IF YOUR CHILD DOES NOT FEEL WELL... PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE  
DO NOT SEND THEM TO CAMP, THIS CAN POSSIBLY EXPOSE OTHERS.**

**Do not come if you feel sick or are showing any flu or cold-like symptoms  
including a runny nose, sneezing, coughing or have a temperature.**

**IF YOUR CHILD FEELS SICK DURING CAMP PARENTS NEED TO COME AND PICK THEM UP PROMPTLY!**

**We will monitor and screen staff and campers daily.**

#### **Some of the measures that we are taking for safety:**

**In following with the CDC Guidelines**

- Strict drop off and pick up procedure (see next page)
- 2 NEW outdoor washing stations
- Campers and staff are required to have a “mask” proper face covering (If they don’t they can not stay! – a fishing buff will OK)
- Drop off kids ready, changed and sun screen lathered!
- Separated Camper areas will have specific hooks for their belongings (backpacks, lunch’s and lifejacket)
- 4 to 5 Separate Covered Camper area locations for land drill and lunch.
- Camper groups will keep all week to ensure proper distancing and restrict mixing groups.
- We will NOT offer Fishing Camp this summer!
- Staff will be assigned specifically to clean and disinfect camper areas, all sailing, windsurfing and other gear used before and after use, ensuring proper sanitizing practices.
- All campers’ areas will be outside for safe ventilation.
- Large water jugs in each area and disposable paper cups
- Only necessary staff for safety, restricting from adding non essential volunteers to the weeks
- LUNCH WILL NOT BE PROVIDED; campers need to bring lunch from home! (Pizza party Friday – Domino Delivery)
- ONLY individually wrapped snacks will be provided.

The guidelines are for increased safety and enjoyment and all participants are expected to comply.  
Anyone deviating from the protocols listed above will be immediately asked to leave, with no exceptions!

**NO SHARING LIFEJACKETS PLEASE SEND YOUR CHILD WITH THEIR OWN  
LIFEJACKET WITH THEIR NAME IN LARGE LETTERS IN BLACK SHARPIE.**

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**PLEASE FOLLOW THE PROCEDURES TO ENSURE SAFETY!**

**Morning Drop Off Procedure: (Drop OFF STARTS AT 9:00)**

*Gates will open at 8:30 am*

The Youth Sailing Summer Camp entrance will be signaled with

2 large Banner Flags (One Blue and one Orange)

There will be a 10x10 tent between them.

Staff members will be waiting for campers at Youth Sailing Entrance.

Camper will exit their car and be checked in by staff member.

Kids will go to their designated area

Parents will continue to drive straight and turn on the small rotunda ahead by the Entrance of the Club  
(there is a cream canopy and a large anchor in the middle)

**NOTE:** Please do not park in the open parking area for the police.

All kids need to be checked in at the same point of entry.

**GATES WILL BE CLOSED AT 10:00 am after the morning drop off**

**Afternoon Pick UP Procedure: (Pick Up STARTS AT 4:00)**

At 3:45 pm we will have a staff member at the Miami Yacht Club Main Entrance Gate.

When parents arrive they will let the staff member know whom they are picking up.

Staff member will radio call to get camper ready in the same area that they were dropped off.

Parents will proceed to drive through and pick up camper/s.

Then continue to drive and turn around in the rotunda.

**NOTE:** IF you need to pick up early, please let staff member know at time of drop off, or call.

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
